### Bird Nesting Facts & Behaviors: When Do Birds Lay Eggs?

Never pick up or handle wild bird eggs. Scents and oils from hands can contaminate the eggs and may harm the young birds or attract predators to the nest. Avoid stressing adult birds when they are brooding the eggs or adjusting their nests. If the adults become too stressed, they may abandon the nest completely and the chicks will not survive.

Because killdeers lay their eggs on open ground, their nests are highly vulnerable to predators. Parent birds will often feign injuries to draw predators away from a nearby nest with its light-colored eggs that have black and brown splotches. Eggs are usually 1.5 inches long and somewhat pointed, so they don't roll easily on flat ground.
