Diagnosis is clinical. No evidence of infection in urine studies. Urethral cancer. May present with voiding symptoms or hematuria. Urethral induration may be noted on physical exam. A urethral mass can be visualized on cystoscopy and confirmed by pathologic diagnosis of biopsy specimen. Radiation cystitis. Hx of pelvic radiation.

Differential Diagnosis. Neonatal onset with failure to pass meconium within 24 hours, abdominal distention, vomiting, and subsequent failure to thrive. Rectal mucosal biopsy showing hypertrophic extrinsic nerve bundles and an absence of ganglion cells in the myenteric and submucosal plexus.
