You must pay \$4,000 toward your covered medical costs before your health plan begins to cover costs. After you pay the \$4,000 deductible, your health plan covers 70% of the costs, and you pay the other 30%. When you've paid \$5,000 out of your pocket toward your medical costs, your plan covers 100% of your costs until your "plan year" renews.

In half of states, households at the midpoint, or median, of spending on out-of-pocket costs had at

least \$1,000 worth of medical expenses. Nebraskans had the highest median household spending on out-of-pocket costs: \$1,500. In four states, households in the top 10 percent of spending on out-of-pocket costs paid \$7,000 or more (Table 2).

How Much US Households with Employer Insurance Spend ...

The out-of-pocket maximum, on the other hand, is the most you'll ever spend out of pocket in a given calendar year. Once you spend enough to reach your plan's limit, the insurer will cover 100% of your medical bills. Both your deductible and out-of-pocket maximum only include certain expenses. Neither one includes your monthly premiums.
