### STUDENTS' PERCEPTIONS OF READING

The students did not perceive that there was much instruction in reading strategies in school. The reading these students perceived as school reading differs from recommendations in the literature.

Students perception of reading was overwhelmingly positive which followed the assumption that they liked reading but this data did not reveal whether it was due to reading programs or not. There is not initial relationship seen from this data between student perception and school directives.

### Fourth Grade Students' Perceptions of Reading Counts ...

The purpose of this study was to measure fifth-grade students' perceptions of reading and various teaching techniques designed to encourage reading motivation. Although the majority of students in this study identified being a good reader as important, very few of these students expressed that reading is something they like to do.

Reading comprehension is one of the reading skills that is needed to be mastered by the students. Reading comprehension plays an important role in students' reading development. However, there are some problems encountered by the students when they are trying to master this skill.

### STUDENTS' PERCEPTIONS ON THE BENEFITS OF RECIPROCAL ...

The perception can be influenced by self-esteem, which in turn is affected by interaction with teachers, classmates, and family, eventually impacting their motivation for reading.But in facts, there were some students who often applied reading strategies have lower score in reading test compared to students who frequently applied the strategies.

### STUDENTS' PERCEPTION ON READING STRATEGIES FOR IMPROVING ...

A quantitative analysis indicates that the reading motivation of one of the classes significantly increased, particularly in regard to values of intrinsic motivation, while the students in the other classes read comparatively larger amount with less of reading motivation enhancement throughout the course.
